- ◆ Registration will be held August 25 and September 1 from 6 PM–7 PM. I highly encourage all families to make one of these times work as the first night will be busy with trying to make sure all new rules are adapted to, getting students to correct classrooms and get teachers what they need.
- ◆ First night of class will be September 8 and these will be “in class teaching”.
- ◆ Temps will be taken on all students and teachers.
- ◆ If anyone has a temp over 99.5 they will be asked to go home. So parents, please walk your child to St Francis Gym doors and wait till their temps are taken before leaving. This way if they have a temp, you are there to take them back home.
- ◆ This year, if you child states they are sick, have an upset stomach, have a headache, sore throat or any illness symptoms, I recommend you keep them home.
- ◆ Students and teachers will be asked to wear a mask during class. There will be hand sanitizer in each room and will be encouraged to be used.

RULES FOR 2021-2022
