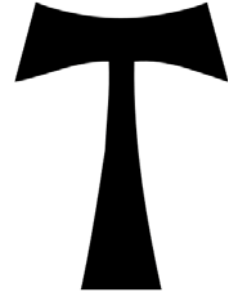

Dear Parishioners,

As we pass the half-way point in our fiscal year, I wanted to thank everyone who has participated in the *Tend the Flame* campaign and the Archbishop's Annual Appeal.

Although the amounts pledged shows generosity from a number of people, one of our issues as a parish family is the number of families participating in these appeals. For our *Tend the Flame* two-year capital campaign, 236 households of the 453 households in our parish have responded (52.1%). For the Archbishop's Annual Appeal, 99 households of the 453 households in our parish have responded (21.9%). Our goal for both campaigns is to have 100% participation by a financial gift, the gift of prayer, or both in each of the respective campaigns. We are all called to share our gifts with our parish and the archdiocese.

The *Tend the Flame* campaign provides necessary revenue for the ongoing operation of our parish and its apostolates. Our parish has so much to offer to so many people, and our life of faith as a parish family continues to deepen because of the opportunities for growth provided to our parishioners.

The Archbishop's Annual Appeal helps provide formation for our priests and deacons who serve in our parishes, providing resource staff to enliven our sacramental and outreach programs, and assisting families in providing Catholic education for their children. Some funds are designated to provide resources to parishes for youth ministry, adult faith formation, and RCIA. Funds from this appeal also provide charity to the homeless and hungry, as well as providing shelter for battered women and children. Our parish has received much in terms of assistance in the past year from the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis, the Archdiocesan Tribunal, and formation workshops for the clergy. Further, following the charism of St. Francis by providing for the needs of the poor and marginalized in the greater archdiocese is essential to our ability to live mercy.

As a parish, let's strive to get to 100% participation in these campaigns through a financial gift, through the gift of prayer, or both. If you need materials for either campaign, please contact the parish office.

The November minutes and January agenda were motioned and approved.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

Administrator's Report:

Mrs. Dunn congratulated Elly Masteller for being selected for All-State Chorus. Congratulations also go out to the one act coaches, cast and crew members for being the Class D-1 State Champions.

On November 20, school was closed due to illness, numerous students absent for One Act and multiple teachers and staff unavailable to report. That being said, this January the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services sent information stating they do not recommend school closures for outbreaks of infectious disease. This is due to studies that have shown that the flu viruses can live and potentially infect a person for only 2 to 8 hours after being deposited on a surface. Their recommendations are to separate sick students and staff from others until they can be picked up to go home, having clean handwashing stations, providing alcohol-based hand sanitizers and having routine surface cleaning. They do fully support administration discretion to close if warranted.

Teacher have had the opportunity to pray together using Lectio Divina (praying with scripture) and WRAP (Write, Reflect, Apply, Pray) with colleagues since November. Starting in Lent, teachers will be using this format to pray with students. This is the same format used in our parish's Adult Faith Formation.

Finances:

Finances were reviewed and no big changes were noted.

President's Comments:

The office of Evangelization and Catechesis will be hosting a Lenten Small Group Initiative at our parish on January 28 in the parish hall.

January Business:

A retention policy for the school was discussed as well as the pastoral strategic plan for our parish. Our cluster of parishes will include St. Francis in Humphrey, Holy Family in Lindsay, St. Michael's in Tarnov and St. Mary's in Leigh with two priests being assigned to this cluster.

St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes
January 23, 2019

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order at 7 PM on Wednesday, January 23, 2019. Fr. Pat led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Pat McLaughlin, Dave Krings, Dan Fehringer, Janet Eisenmenger, Kevin Small and Kari Wieseler. Ken Classen, DeAnna Heinen, Duane Kosch and Lindsey Kosch were excused.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

No report.

Finance Board:

The parish is ahead on financial reports as compared to this time last year, mainly due to the “Tend the Flame” campaign. The collection Sunday giving and general school support is currently at 70% as compared to the last fiscal year, mainly suspected to be due to the general economy.

Development:

The “Tend the Flame” campaign has resulted in 236 responses from 455 envelope holders. Approximately \$395,000 of our \$500,000 goal has been pledged. There will likely be another attempt at collecting additional responses this fall. The Archbishop’s annual appeal is down in comparison to last year, however Fr. Pat anticipated an increase in this week’s contribution due to a preliminary report.

OLD BUSINESS:

Fr. Pat has obtained additional quotes on the Verden Bells and discussion will be continued at the next meeting due to a reduced attendance at this month’s meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

The pastoral vision of the Archdiocese of Omaha continues to work on the strategic plan. The current update confirms that our future parish cluster will include St. Francis in Humphrey, Holy Family in Lindsay, St. Michael’s in Tarnov and St. Mary’s in Leigh. In doing this, there will also be a reduction from 3.83 full-time priests to two priests to cover all four parishes. Currently, there are seven weekend Masses across these parishes, so there will need to be discussion on potentially moving Mass times to accommodate scheduling. Fr. Pat noted that all finances will be kept separate and each parish will remain its own corporate entity. The decision to remove chaplains out of schools has been confirmed. Discussion was held on how the parish will continue to focus and support our campus ministry going forward.

There has been an inquiry on whether we have considered lending out our bazaar games to outside individuals, businesses, etc. There is currently no policy regarding this option. The council discussed options which Fr. Pat will discuss with the games committee.

The meeting adjourned at 7:52 PM.

Fr. Pat led the closing prayer.

The next meeting is scheduled to be held on February 20, 2019.
