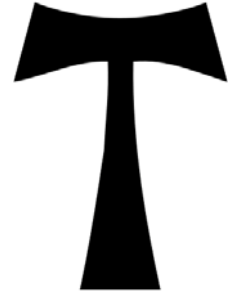

Cluster Information

Holy Family, St. Francis, St. Mary and St. Michael

Notes from cluster planning committee:

“The committee for our Parish Cluster between Lindsay, Humphrey, Tarnov and Leigh, along with Fr. Olsen, have set a weekend Mass schedule for the four parishes:

- Lindsay – 5:00 PM Saturday and 8:30 AM Sunday
- Humphrey – 5:30 PM Saturday and 10:00 AM Sunday
- Tarnov – 10:30 AM Sunday
- Leigh – 8:30 AM Sunday

In addition, there needs to be a workable schedule for weekends where only one priest is present, as the other priest may be on vacation, retreat or participating in ministries/events on the archdiocesan level. The proposed one priest weekend schedule is as follows:

- Lindsay – 5:00 PM Saturday and 8:30 AM Sunday
- Humphrey – 6:30 PM Saturday and 10:00 AM Sunday

Please continue to pray for our cluster and the many transitions we need to make.”

Daily Mass schedule:

- 8:00AM every day for grade school in Lindsay and Humphrey
- One Mass a week for the high school
- CCD will have one Mass a month at each parish

Priests will alternate Masses for the weekend at all the parishes. Holy days and holidays will be scheduled on a trial basis to determine what will work best. (Will revisit weekend Mass schedule in a year.)

Fr. Olsen and Fr. Wayne need to meet to figure out expenses for the parish budgets and get that info to each parish.

Fr. Olsen said all parish councils from each parish will remain the same. He will get to as many meetings as he can.

Visiting the Sick – Father will meet with the deacons to work out a possible plan.

Each of our parishes are asked to email a list of events for the next year to Fr. Olsen esolsen@archomaha.org. Lindsay and Humphrey please include school calendar events.

Fr. Olsen asked that we do not take any more Mass intentions at this point.

Fr. Olsen asked to meet with the administrative people from each parish on May 22 at 5:30 PM in Humphrey in the church basement. Please let the administrative (bookkeeper and bulletin) people in each of your parishes know. (Jenna, will you make sure the church basement is available and the doors will be open? Thank you!)

Bulletin: Fr. Pat will put out prototype for us by email.

Fr. Olsen will reside in Lindsay, and Fr. Wayne in Humphrey.

Thank you for your leadership, Fr. Pat!

Our pastor, Fr. Pat McLaughlin is leaving St. Francis of Assisi to begin a new assignment at Sacred Heart Parish in Norfolk, Nebraska. Fr. Pat joined our St. Francis family in June of 2013.

Fr. Pat held himself and us up to the highest moral and Catholic principles, following the guidelines of the Church. During his time here, he kicked off the Ignite St. Francis Campaign followed by the Tend the Flame Campaign to meet the continuing costs of running a parish and school. He established the St. Francis improvement fund, and started a school raffle to help balance the budget. The completion of an additional acre of land for our cemetery was finalized.

Helping all to deepen their prayer life was a priority for Fr. Pat. He instituted daily staff prayer and WRAP was introduced to staff, students and the parishioners. The PEACE Corps was developed as well as Holy Grounds and Pints with the Priest. A Faith Formation Committee was also formed. Totus Tuus was reintroduced back to St. Francis of Assisi.

In an effort to help parishioners and visitors to have a personal relationship with God the adoration chapel was renovated. To help us hear the celebration of the Mass and Liturgy a new sound system was installed in our church. Fr. Pat was also involved in setting up the new school/parish website.

Fr. Pat was instrumental in helping the four parishes prepare for the formation of our parish clusters.

During the week, Fr. Pat was busy spending time in the high school classrooms teaching Chemistry, Catholic Replies and 7th grade study skills. He also visited our elementary grade school students, celebrated daily Mass, amongst his many other priestly duties such as marriage prep, etc. He also registered all the Coke rewards points to earn items for our school.

During his “free” time, Fr. Pat enjoyed taking walks around Skyview park in Norfolk, working out at the YMCA, baking cookies or muffins for the Blue and White Night. He is famous around Humphrey for his signature caramels. Oh yes, Fr. Pat likes his Diet Coke and Jelly Belly jelly beans and he is exceedingly generous.

These are just a few of his many accomplishments here at St. Francis. We thank you, Fr. Pat, for your service to St. Francis, and we wish you the best of luck in the future!

Pastor's Comments

It has been decided that the school will go to a modified traditional school day.

Pam Goering has agreed to return to St. Francis this fall, if possible, if we are unable to fill the music teacher position.

With Sra. Runnels retiring, we are looking into options for Spanish, including doing Spanish at Humphrey Public Schools.

Financials

Financial reports were reviewed. Sunday giving is down at both the church and school but endowment interest is up as is tuition income. There will be a savings on priests salaries with the clustering of parishes.

Copier for Parish Office

The copier in the parish office is in need of replacement. After reviewing different quotes, it was decided that we would purchase a Sharp printer.

Water Tanks for Gym Lobby

There is a problem with the lack of water pressure in the gym lobby. The consensus was to purchase a pump to take care of this issue.

Cafeteria

We commend our cafeteria staff for another year of excellent meals. Because of the many foods being made from scratch and the efforts on Rebecca's part to take advantage of excellent purchasing opportunities, our student lunch prices will remain the same for the 2019/2020 school year.

A reverse osmosis system will be installed in the cafeteria. This system will make it possible for the staff to have purified water, not only for drinking, but for cooking as well.

The dishwasher is on its last leg. While it is still in running condition, we do not know how long this will be the case. Rebecca is looking into prices so we are prepared when the need arises to replace it.

Maintenance

The boiler in the grade school requires an updated burner and flame system. We have received two bids and we will accept the lower of these two.

Kindergarten Aids for 2019/2020 School Year

We anticipate a kindergarten class of 23. Due to the large class size, we will need an aid in that classroom throughout the day. Mrs. Julie Huettner will continue to assist Mrs. Beller in the morning and the grade school secretary, Mrs. Hassenstab, will assist her in the afternoon.

The meeting closed with a prayer led by Fr. Pat.
