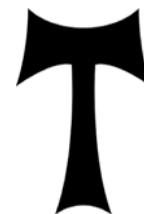

Dear Parishioners,

Nothing is more certain to attract a bigger crowd than the presence of something amazing. Whether it's watching Neil Armstrong walk on the moon, listening to the greatest band in the world or simply the grandeur of the Super Bowl, there is something about the spectacular that piques our curiosity.

It comes as no surprise, then, why the spectacular works of Jesus Christ attract such a huge following. Not only would those ill or possessed by demons travel miles through the most difficult terrain in the hope of being cured by Jesus, but also the presence of the spectacular attracts curiosity seekers as well. Is it any wonder, then, why Simon Peter, upon seeing the continuous swelling of the crowd exclaims, after one miracle, "Lord, everyone is looking for you"?

How does Jesus respond? Curiously, Jesus responds by reminding St. Peter that not everyone is looking for Him. "Let us go on to the nearby villages," Jesus says, "that I may preach there also." You see, it is not that Jesus wants to deprive a particular region of His presence. Quite the contrary, Jesus wants to bring His revelation of God the Father to as many souls as the limits of His humanity permit Him.

Where the limits of Jesus' humanity end, the boundlessness of Jesus divinity begins. Think of it this way: Before His crucifixion, Jesus is limited in His ability to preach this message personally by the confines of His humanity. When Jesus rises from the dead and ascends to the right hand of God the Father, He is able to petition the Father to send the apostles the Holy Spirit.

What does the Holy Spirit do? The Holy Spirit makes the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity present in our world in a variety of ways. Supreme among these ways is Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist. When a Catholic priest says Mass anywhere in the world, He uses the power of the Holy Spirit to change ordinary bread and wine into the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ.

Because this real presence of Jesus Christ is housed in every tabernacle everywhere in the world, Jesus Christ is more accessible to us now than He was to the Jews some two thousand years ago. And, today we possess many of the same difficulties possessed by the Jews at the time of Jesus. How blessed we are, then, to also have the same presence of Jesus Christ, available in a special way in Eucharistic Adoration, that longs to cure us of these ailments just as much as He longed to cure the Jews.

But, perhaps the most important benefit of Eucharistic Adoration is the recognition of the need for repentance in our own lives. It is in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament that we are instructed personally by Jesus Christ both where we have succeeded and where we have fallen short. Armed with this information, we can then grow more completely into the person Jesus Christ is calling us to be.

When this happens, the effects are spectacular. We will become better witnesses to the truth that Jesus Christ proclaims through us, which, in turn, draws more people to the presence of Jesus Christ until those words St. Peter spoke to Jesus become truly universal. Everyone is looking for Jesus.

But, in order to achieve any of these benefits, the first sacrifice we have to make is to the sacrifice to adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, which is why I so rejoice that we are able to do this at St. Francis every Thursday. I must confess, though, that I do wonder why it's not even more. After all, if a golfer had the opportunity to meet one on one with Tiger Woods for a whole hour every single week, almost nothing would stand in the way of this weekly lesson. And we're talking about something infinitely greater than Tiger Woods here because this lesson is not only far more important, it is also with Jesus Christ, God Himself, present body, blood, soul and divinity, at every hour of the day or night in the most Blessed Sacrament.

Fiscal year to date financial reports were reviewed.

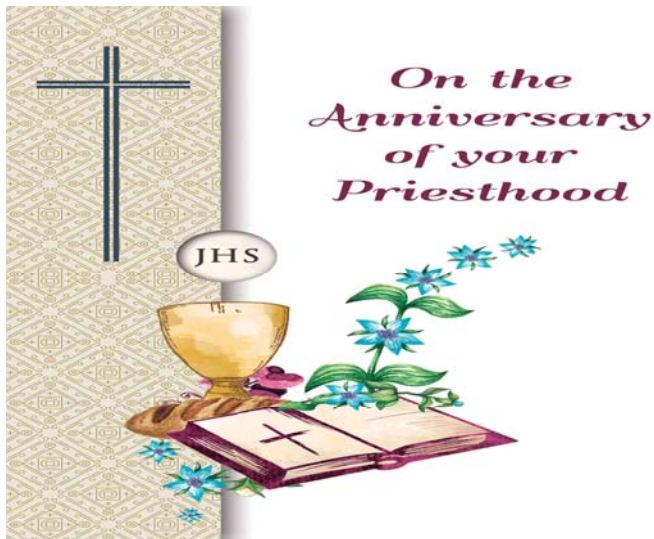
Fr. Olsen brought up doing a raffle. The board tabled it.

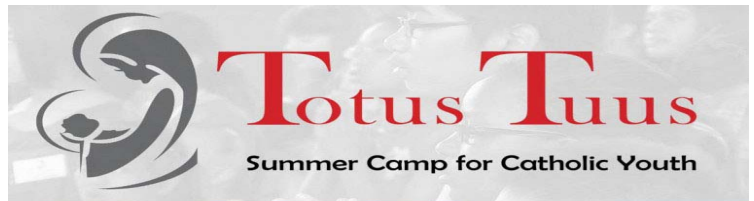
