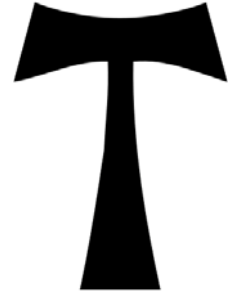

Dear Parishioners,

As you know, the Archdiocese of Omaha has been very good about being in compliance with the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People that was constructed by the bishops of the United States in light of the abuse scandal in the Church. This Charter serves as the framework for the efforts of the (arch)dioceses in the United States for the implementation of specific plans of actions. Recently, this Charter was revisited and revised by the bishops of our country.

In light of these new revisions, Archbishop George Lucas has stated that new standards for safe environment training will now apply to additional employees and volunteers who have some contact with minors, even if that contact is occasional. Clarifications need to be received in order to see how this will impact our parish, but it may be the case that those who have served in various volunteer positions may now need safe environment training and/or a background check to continue in these positions.

In this time of crisis in our Church, we need to be ever vigilant to ensure no one ever falls prey to a perpetrator of this type of evil. As a Church, we need to be a leading example of providing a safe environment for all people.



St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes
February 20, 2019

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order at 7 PM on Wednesday, February 20, 2019. Fr. Pat led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Pat McLaughlin, Dave Krings, Dan Fehringer, DeAnna Heinen, Duane Kosch, Janet Eisenmenger, Kevin Small and Kari Wieseler. Ken Classen and Lindsey Kosch were excused.

The minutes from the January 23 meeting were read and approved as written.

The parish pastoral council members present, as a group, discussed the contents of chapter three in the book, "Catholic and Christian", written by Alan Schreck.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

No report.

Finance Board:

During the July 2018-February 2019 time frame, endowment interest in the amount of \$191,500 were used to fund \$87,800 for the school and \$103,700 for the church. In regards to the 2019-20 school year, the proposal from the finance board included a zero tuition increase and a 1.5% raise for staff. The proposal was reviewed by the parish pastoral council members; a motion to approve the proposal was made by Duane Kosch and seconded by DeAnna Heinen.

Development:

There has been an increase in pledges toward the "Tend the Flame" campaign at this point, but it was again mentioned that there will likely be another attempt at collecting additional responses this fall. The alumni newsletter has been released, and planning is currently underway for the alumni banquet and Blue and White Night.

OLD BUSINESS:

Fr. Pat provided a quote for a one-year service contract for the Verdin bells. The contract was discussed in detail, and the council agreed to decline the contract at this time as it was not cost effective to pay the contract as it covered minimal services under the quote. Glenn Heinen has agreed to take care of the annual servicing of the bells.

NEW BUSINESS:

To adhere to fire code, Little Saints Daycare is in need of updating the sprinkler system. Since the daycare is incorporated through the church, Fr. Pat proposed using undesignated memorial gifts to fund this need. The committee discussed and approved this proposal. As of the meeting date, the church elevator is temporarily out of service. Repair parts are on order, and repairs are expected

to be completed by next week. Fr. Pat mentioned that replacing the elevator may be necessary in the future.

PASTOR'S REPORT

No decision regarding priest changes or assignments to the cluster has been made at this time.

Teacher evaluations have been completed, and letters of intent will be given next week.

The meeting adjourned at 8:11 PM.

Fr. Pat led the closing prayer.

The next meeting is scheduled to be held on March 20, 2019.
