Dear Parishioners,

As we enter the heat of the summer I write my last article and wish to speak briefly of the Holy Eucharist once again, which brings us Christ's food and drink for the journey. We all are on this journey, hoping to have eternal life with Christ in the eternal kingdom of Heaven.

The Eucharist is to be our spiritual food and drink to nourish and strengthen us for our journey, to allow Christ's presence to remain in us and thus having the Holy Spirit guide us in our daily living. This is true, though we need to be open to the graces that are offered and open to that which the Spirit is asking of us. With this guidance, then, we live in Christ, experiencing His Peace. The Holy Eucharist, with Jesus as the Good Shepherd, has always been an image and center of my priesthood. The one weakness I have found for me is that one needs to also speak where one wishes to lead the sheep. My quiet-ness has caused great distress here in this community. In some ways I wish I could go back to my youth when I said what I thought, throwing caution to the wind, instead of how I am today. Maybe the Spirit can give me the graces to go back that direction a bit. The Spirit, I believe, has told me what to do, and I have followed, but I have not done the best in saying what the Spirit inspires me to always say.

This past weekend, Fr. Dan mentioned during his homily, that it has been 31 years since our ordination and first Mass. The heat of this last weekend reminded me of the day of my first Mass, for it was as hot that day as I was giving my first blessing to family and friends outside. This first blessing is an old custom done by most priests either the day of ordination or following their first Mass. It was that day that my journey as a priest of God began, and what a journey, so far, it has been. From being "in charge" of a parish within a week of those happy events, while the pastor went to Europe, to being moved mid-year to become a pastor while still having all the responsibilities I already had until a replacement came. This cluster of parishes and the work I was called to do was, yes, a challenge, but one I was willing to take on. My health, unfortunately, wasn't as able to deal with things. I will say I wish I could stay and see the endeavor of the new grade school come to flourishing success, but it is not to be. The article about this wonderful happening is truly an inspiration to better and glorious things ahead for this community. I wish you all the success in the world. As I divert from this path of my journey to go on sabbatical and whatever the Spirit has in store ahead for me, I can say it has been an interesting ride so far.



## Cemetery Regulations/Decorations:


It is not permissible to plant anything on the cemetery plot. The cemetery management has the right to remove any or all decorations when deemed necessary and reserves the right to remove all floral designs, flowers, shrubs or trees as soon as they become unsightly or dangerous to the property. Pope Leo XIV will bless and impose Archbishop Michael G. McGovern's pallium during the celebration of the Mass for the feast of Sts. Peter and Paul in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome.



How many Pallia will be blessed?

In addition to Archbishop George M. McGovern, the following men will also have their pallia blessed at the June 29 Mass: Cardinal Robert W. McElroy of Washington; Archbishop W. Shawn McKnight of Kansas City, Kansas; Archbishop Robert G. Casey of Cincinnati; Archbishop Joe S. Vásquez of Galveston-Houston; Archbishop Jeffrey S. Grob of Milwaukee; Archbishop Richard G. Henning of Boston; and Archbishop Edward J. Weisenburger of Detroit.

The pallium is a papal liturgical symbol and insignia of an archbishop. When an archbishop is appointed to a new archdiocese, he requests a pallium from the Holy See. The pallium is a stole-like vestment worn over the chasuble when the archbishop celebrates Mass. It symbolizes the archbishop's authority and his unity with the Pope.
