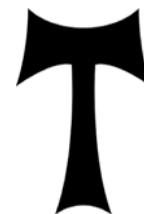

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin the month of April, we oftentimes think heavily along the lines of spring. For April showers ought to bring May Flowers. Farmers are preparing for the planting season, and school is beginning to wind down. Liturgically, April is the month most parishes schedule time of First Holy Communion. For those receiving the Lord for the first time, it is very exciting; the anticipation of what it will be like and how one may feel after receiving the consecrated host. What a wonderful opportunity each time we receive our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and the many graces it brings to help nourish our soul to be strengthened to fight against the temptations of the evil one.

First Communions are one of my favorite celebrations. Seeing the joy and excitement in the children's faces along with being able to profess their faith in God on their own. This year one thing that people who attend First Communion Mass will see differently is that during the Profession of Faith the First Communicants will be holding their lit baptismal candle. This is to help keep the symbolism and connection of Baptism and Holy Communion, two of the three sacraments of initiation into the Roman Catholic Faith.

Normally when I preach at First Communion, I center it around the children and the meaning of the body, blood, soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is an awesome gift that the Lord gives to us, His very self under the appearance of bread and wine. In this sacrament we are to hold our Lord Jesus Christ close to our hearts experiencing and knowing His great sacrificial love for us. It is not just bread and wine as so many believe; it is truly, absolutely, and completely the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ who suffered and died for us.

I ask you to join me in praying for those who will be receiving our Lord for the first time in this holy sacrament. May they throughout their lives, see our Lord truly present in the Holy Eucharist, having that desire and longing to receive Him always with reverence and love.

St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes
March 4, 2024

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the vice president, Erik Baumgart, at 7:03 PM on Tuesday, March 4, 2024. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Erik Baumgart, Spencer Eisenmenger, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Katie McPhillips, Bryan Reichmuth, Steve Wieser and Kari Wieseler. Brad Stallbaumer was excused.

The minutes from the January 29, 2024, meeting were reviewed and one change to be noted that the teacher contracts were handed out in February, not March as stated.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

Parent/Teacher conferences were held and it was noted that attendance was down compared to the fall conferences.

Mrs. Dunn is working on the calendar for the 2024-25 school year.

The increased amount of snow days this winter has not impacted the amount of total hours needed for this school year.

It was announced that a 4% raise was approved for teachers and support staff for next year.

Finance Board:

No recent meetings have been held.

Teacher and support staff pay increases of 4% were approved by the board.

The board has begun its preliminary budget and tuition review for the next school year.

Collections are down approximately 19% compared to last year.

Development:

The community center has been booked for next year's Blue and White Night.

The development director has begun working on the next alumni newsletter.

The Pizza, Puzzles and Pints night was a success. The profits from the night were used to purchase some of the new tables needed, A generous donor came forward with an additional donation to ensure all of the tables were able to be replaced.

OLD BUSINESS:

Due to the busy Mass schedule, the full carpet cleaning will be postponed until May. A spot cleaning will be done prior to Easter to take care of some of the noticeable spots. There is a concern with the wear of the steps to the entrance of the church as well as a seam on the south side of the church. Kari Wieseler will contact Complete Floors to see if we can get a quote to repair/replace the carpet in these areas.

NEW BUSINESS:

Parish Council elections were held. Spencer Eisenmenger was nominated by Kari Wieseler as parish pastoral council president and seconded by Sarah Kessler. Steve Wieser volunteered to serve as the vice president of the council and Brad Stallbaumer was nominated to serve as secretary.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Below is a current plan for Holy Week:

- Monday both Fr. Stan and Fr. Matt will attend the Chrism Mass in Omaha.
- Holy Thursday: Two Mass times-St. Francis, Humphrey/Holy Family, Lindsay
- Good Friday: Three Service times-3 PM in Ss. Cyril & Methodius, Clarkson; 7 PM at St. Francis, Humphrey; and Holy Family, Lindsay
- Easter Vigil: Two Mass times: Holy Family, Lindsay/St. Mary's, Leigh
- Easter Sunday: Five Masses will be offered.

The summer schedule for Saturday night Mass is looking at a time change sometime in May or June.

Going forward all councils will be parish elect, with two trustees still being appointed by Pastor.

Questions on how finances will work moving forward was discussed. There are many moving pieces, councils, etc., and a way to streamline information was discussed.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 16, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

St. Francis of Assisi School Board Minutes
March 12, 2024

The St. Francis school board met on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, in the St. Francis parish office. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Mrs. Jennifer Dunn, Brent Reichmuth, Katie McPhillips, Diane Noonan, Ann Olmer and Todd Preister. Jared Wiehn was excused.

Diane Noonan opened the meeting with a prayer.

The meeting agenda was approved by Todd Preister and seconded by Ann Olmer.

The minutes of last month's meeting were approved by Katie McPhillips and seconded by Todd Preister.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

Administrator's Report:

Mrs. Dunn commended the speech team on a fine season and congratulated the girls and boys basketball teams for making it to the state tournament.

Mrs. Dunn explained that there are ads seeking a music teacher and a religion teacher but only because the government requires efforts be made to try to hire domestic people. All teaching positions are filled.

- Mr. Bret Atkins from Lindsay Holy Family will replace our current business teacher and will become an assistant A.D.
- Mr. Travis Willnerd from Lindsay Holy Family will teach 7th, 8th and 9th grade religion and help with other duties.
- Mr. Jon Krings, a Humphrey St. Francis alum, will teach 7th, 8th and 9th grade English and assist with Catholicity efforts.

A new family plans to enroll their three children in St. Francis Elementary school in the fall.

Mrs. Dunn responded to a request for a week-long spring break to be added to next year's calendar. Due to requirements set forth by NDE accreditation and additional requirements set forth by the Archdiocese, including a Spring Break would require the academic calendar to be lengthened—beginning earlier in August or going later in May, or both. The Spring Break was suggested to help accommodate families that take vacations during the school year. The school cannot prioritize accommodating family vacations during the academic school year.

A new communication system to replace Sycamore is being considered. Options are available that are more user friendly for families with students in multiple schools and have a variety of convenient features within one system.

Finances:

The finances were reviewed. Fr. Stan mentioned that health insurance costs continue to increase over the years. This coming fiscal year, there will be a 5% increase.

One of the Suburban's is in need of repair.

President's Comments:

Overall things are going well considering all of the restructuring. Fr. Stan was thankful that all teaching positions are filled.

Graduation will be held in church.

Fr. Stan will meet with Ron Schroeder soon to look at the grade school boiler.

Many parishioners volunteered to serve on the Archangel's reorganization subcommittees. They continue to meet and make steady progress.

The current cleaning service performs light, routine duties but does not deep clean nearly as well as when we had hourly custodial staff. A suggestion of having parents of students spend several hours after each quarter to assist with this was discussed and tabled.

New Business:

In order to be accredited, schools must report academic scores to the board. Mrs. Braun shared with the Board 2023-2024 academic data. She shared both Star Reading and Math data along with ACT and ACRE test results. Reporting academic data is an accreditation requirement.

Tuition for next year is in the process of being decided. Fr. Stan wants to eliminate tuition tiers and make one amount for grades 1 through 6.

The St. Francis Elementary Family Handbook was reviewed and no changes were made. A request to include in the handbook a timeframe when uniform shorts are allowed was unanimously rejected. The board felt that the temperatures through the buildings varies significantly, and it makes more sense to layer clothing to adjust for comfort as necessary. The board also felt this was a parental decision.

The next meeting of the school board will be held on Thursday, April 11, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting was adjourned with a prayer led by Katie McPhillips at 8:45 PM.

Fiscal year-to-date financial reports were reviewed and approved.

The 2024/2025 budget was discussed. The elementary school budget was updated and the high school budget is not yet completed. Approval of the final budget was tabled until the high school budget is completed.

Tuition rates were discussed for the 2024/2025 school year and set as follows:

- Kindergarten - \$2,800
- 1st - 4th - \$3,400
- 5th - 6th - \$3,600

Fr. Stan shared that there will be a combined board meeting for all Family of Parish board members on April 17, 2024, at 6 PM in the St. Francis parish hall.

The next meeting is scheduled for April 23, 2024, at 7 PM

The meeting closed with a prayer at 9:06 PM.

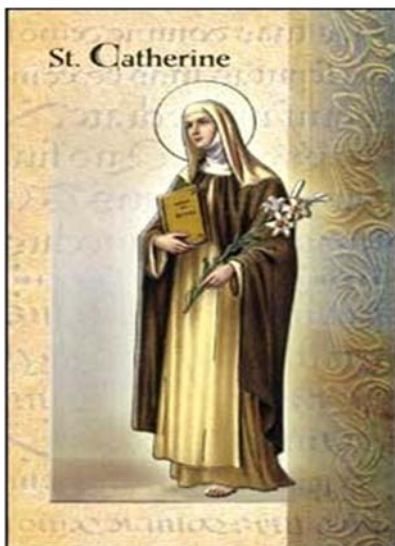
