Dear Parishioners,

The month of April brings us Easter and this year Easter is the latest it almost can be April 20. The week before Easter is called Holy Week, beginning with the Passion or Palm Sunday, remembering the Lord's entrance into Jerusalem. On Monday of that week the priest's throughout the archdiocese go to the Cathedral to celebrate the Chrism Mass with the Archbishop. At this special liturgy, not only are the oils of catechumens and the infirm blessed, but the Chrism is consecrated. The Chrism is consecrated for it is to be used in all the sacraments that leave an indelible mark or character upon the soul. Also at this Mass the priest's renew the promises they made on the day of their ordination to follow the bishop and to serve the people of God, celebrating the Sacraments for their good.

This year during the Triduum, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, we are going to implement the praying of morning prayer, part of the Liturgy of the Hours, as a way of uniting us with the Church universal. The Liturgy of the Hours is the prayer of the Church and is prayed by all ordained ministers, religious and often by those who are not able to celebrate the Holy Mass in their parish so they can gather together as a community of Faith to praise God.

The structure of morning prayer begins with the sign of the cross and a hymn, has three psalms or two psalms and a canticle, a short reading followed by a responsorial and then comes the gospel canticle (Canticle of Zechariah from Luke 1:68-79), intercessions followed by the Our Father and concluding prayer and blessing. I invite everyone to come and partake of this beautiful form of prayer for ourselves and our church.

May the Lord God shower His many graces and blessings upon us as we draw closer to the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection this Easter.

The meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:05 PM on Thursday, February 13, 2025. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Spencer Eisenmenger, Erik Baumgart, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Michael Ramaekers, Bryan Reichmuth, Steve Wieser and Kari Wieseler. Ann Olmer was excused. Guest in attendance was Bob Preister.

Bob Preister spoke to the council regarding the sewer smell in the grade school. Bob looked and would like to install a bypass pipe in order to provide proper ventilation for the bathrooms. The council approved and thanked Mr. Preister for his willingness to help out with this situation.

The minutes from the January 8, 2025, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

St. Francis School Board:

Igniter on the boiler did go out, and the new one was installed and is working.

Due to insurance policy issues, Archangels Catholic or St. Francis schools are no longer able to use the Humphrey Public school buses. This poses more of an issue with ACHS than St. Francis as parents usually volunteer to drive when needed.

The school lunch cost of seconds went up to \$1.75 due to the increased cost of food.

Currently reviewing and updating handbooks for the 2025-26 school year.

The title school services will be decreasing for St. Francis due to an increased need for services at Humphrey Public. The time allotted for St. Francis is not yet known at this time.

Finance Board:

Sunday giving is on a good pattern. The daycare and cafeteria are trying to mitigate unexpected expenses, such as increased minimum wage increases and appliances, with increased rates.

Development:

The alumni newsletters have been sent out. Plans are in process for the alumni banquet to be held on May 31. The date of the banquet is not Memorial Day weekend due to the school sport season running later this year. This year's alumni banquet will be a joint event to include alumni of both St. Francis and Archangels.

OLD BUSINESS:

The majority of the light bulbs have been changed out in the church. Some electrical work needs to be done when the carpet installation occurs.

Carpet samples were provided and approved. We can now proceed with picking an installation date as two generous donors have covered the cost of the carpet. Potential installation dates are May 12 or May 23. We will look for someone to lead coordination efforts for the installation (removing pews, organizing helpers, etc).

An individual has stepped up to lead the coordination of the Safe Environment program.

In regards to the parish pictorial, a representative is still needed from Clarkson in order to proceed.

Additional discussion was held on the bus situation and the potential need to consider the purchase of a bus and potentially look for additional drivers to obtain the appropriate licensing.

There was a question in regards to the formation of advisory boards for the daycare, and the development director. This item is up for discussion during next week's finance meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Glenn Heinen expressed a need to inspect the church clocks. Glenn was given quotes for an inspection and maintenance of the church clocks. The quote was approved by Sarah Kessler and seconded by Spencer Eisenmenger.

There was a concern raised about the condition of the flat part of the roof on the church. Erik Baumgart agreed to get quotes on the repair.

Per request, the bylaws of the parish council are going to be obtained from Fr. Scott Hastings in regards to frequency of inspections, facility walkthroughs, etc.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Jim Stolz is planning to visit and do a walkthrough of the facilities. The council requested a discussion to be held with Mr. Stolz in regards to limitations and openness to restarting school improvement discussions.

There has been a ticketing system put into place for Ron's janitorial duties. This will help Ron prioritize issues across the campus and allow him access to additional resources needed to assist with larger projects.

Due to the number of families that missed the initial meeting, Fr. Stan may look into scheduling another First Communion meeting.

There are plans to develop a committee to represent our parish cluster, as well as a separate finance board for the new Archangels Catholic High School.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:39 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

St. Francis of Assisi Parish Finance Board Meeting Minutes March 12, 2025

The meeting of the finance board opened with prayer led by Lisa Krings at 5:31 PM on Wednesday, March 12, 2025. President, Bryan Reichmuth, called the meeting to order.

Roll call was taken. Those present were Fr. Stan, Lisa Krings, Kevin Small, Ashley Krings, Carol Wemhoff, Bryan Reichmuth, Dan Fehringer and Deb Herchenbach. Spencer Eisenmenger, David Wegener, Brent Reichmuth and Tim Werner were excused. Mrs. Jennifer Dunn was present as a guest.

Mrs. Dunn gave an update about enrollment at the elementary school. The size of Kindergarten over the next three years, based on baptismal records could range anywhere from mid-20-40. Based on the numbers, a dual track kindergarten is being recommended. In addition, Mrs. Dunn requested that the approval of a school resource/guidance counselor be added. This role would be able to take on many of the administrative duties that come with the increasing number of students and students with special needs. The position would allow the guidance counselor at the high school to fill some of the gaps created by the elimination of one position at the high school for next school year as well as allow the guidance counselor to be more available to the high school students.

Deb Herchenbach provided an update on the Archangels budget and the expected subsidy needed from St. Francis for next fiscal year.

The St. Francis church and school budgets were reviewed. Ashley Krings made a motion to approve the budgets and Kevin Small seconded. All were in favor.

Bryan Reichmuth brought up potential increase in building improvements due to drainage and leaking roofs.

The next meeting will be held Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at 6 PM.

Fr. Stan closed with a prayer at 6:30 PM.




