#### Dear Parishioners.

There is much confusion when it comes to the Immaculate Conception and it's meaning. This important aspect of our Faith is stated in this fashion: The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception was defined on December 8, 1854, by Pope Pius IX. It declares that "The Blessed Virgin Mary, at the first instant of her conception, by a singular privilege and grace of the Omnipotent God, in virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, the Savior of mankind, was preserved immaculate from all stain of original sin." This doctrine is not found explicitly stated anywhere in the Bible. However, it has been part of Catholic tradition from the earliest centuries of the church and, therefore, the liturgy applies scripture in an accommodated sense to highlight key aspects of the teaching.

Now we all know our Holy Days of Obligation; we learned them in school. The Immaculate Conception is on December 8, and we recall Mary being conceived by Ann without original sin, making her perfect just as Eve was perfect when she was created by God. In this way, she was the fitting vessel or tabernacle for our Lord Jesus Christ to enter into our world.

In the Gospel from Luke on this holy day we hear of the angel, Gabriel, coming to Mary. The first two things proclaimed about Mary from the angel, Gabriel, is that she is full of grace and that she has found favor with God. Grace and favor are the divine qualifications through which Mary will become the Mother of the Son of the Most High. It is precisely from this perspective that the Church throughout the centuries has concluded that such an immaculate vessels must be thoroughly without flaw, thus the Church's conclusion that Mary was untouched by original sin or immaculately conceived.

This year the Immaculate Conception is celebrated on December 9. Why is this? The 8<sup>th</sup> is the First Sunday of Advent so it takes liturgical precedence to the Immaculate Conception, so it is transferred to the next day. Even though it is a Monday and normally if a holy day falls on a Saturday or Monday, except for Christmas, it does not carry the obligation to attend Holy Mass. Why then does the Immaculate Conception of Mary carry the obligation? The main reason is that this solemnity is our national feast day, and the Holy Father has said it needs to be celebrated. Every country in the world has at least one saint as its patron. One of Mexico's is Our Lady of Guadalupe which is celebrated on December 12. In the United States this is a major feast.

Let us then not get too far ahead of ourselves as we travel through December, looking so forward to Christmas and the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ that we forget about the other significant feasts that make it all possible.

### St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes October 16, 2024

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:06 PM on Wednesday, October 16, 2024. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Spencer Eisenmenger, Erik Baumgart, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Kari Wieseler and Mike Ramaekers. Ann Olmer, Bryan Reichmuth, Steve Wieser and Brad Stallbaumer were excused.

The minutes from the September 16, 2024, meeting were reviewed and inquiry was made in regards to the omission of the Safe Environment discussion. Fr. Stan agreed to include this in the minutes of the current meeting.

Minutes were otherwise approved as written.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### **School Board:**

Community service day for the high school is scheduled for October 30, 2024. Asking community members and parents to help. The grade school may possibly dismiss early that day to accommodate clean-up efforts in the grade school building – this is yet to be determined.

Mrs. Dunn has sent out forms to families for the new textbook loan program. This will enable our schools to choose our own textbooks and update where new ones are needed. We will no longer be limited to use only what the public school has available for textbooks. This also provides greater flexibility for our teachers and staff and creates a more streamline process.

Fr. Stan is working with Fr. Dan to get a schedule set up for grade school students to attend confession one to two times per month.

We are continuing to work towards bringing Pre-K under the St. Francis K-6 school system, and are still planning on a fall 2025 start.

At the time of the meeting, there are still no applicants for the open school board seat.

#### **Finance Board:**

Nothing to report at the time of the meeting. The next finance board meeting is currently scheduled for the week of October 21.

#### **Development:**

2024 Blue and White Night invitations have been sent out. The development board would like to encourage everyone to invite someone new to join us at this year's event as St. Francis School keeps 100% of the funds raised.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Fr. Stan is looking for someone from each parish to assist with coordinating the parish directory for our cluster. Kari Wieseler has volunteered to join this committee representing St. Francis Parish. Fr. Stan will reach out to the other parishes for representatives and begin planning with the company that will be putting this together for our parish families.

Spencer Eisenmenger reached out to the interested party to gain details about the potential ideas surrounding the clean up of Fr. Wayne's sanctuary area. The council agreed that there would be no issue with this and suggested that this be added to the list for the planned October 30 Community Service Day.

Lengthy discussion was held in regards to Safe Environment training. There have been several questions as to when and for whom Safe Environment training is required as there is some variability in different situations. Fr. Stan is in the process of evaluating currently-trained individuals and their status of training expiration dates.

The council has decided to delay the replacement of the church carpet until next spring. This decision was made to better coordinate with other planned activities and to ensure optimal timing for the project.

As previously mentioned, the transition team that was in place is going to be the new ACHS school board. The board met and function was discussed, and they are planning to meet again next week. There was a request by the council to know whether the bylaws will be made public. Fr. Stan will follow up with this action, and officers will be determined at the next meeting as well.

More discussion was held around creating a position of an elementary principal for St. Francis. No decision has been made regarding this.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

The council discussed parish circle dues and the potential to increase these dues for those who do not partake in the church cleanings, etc., and it was decided not to increase dues at this time.

Brad Stallbaumer resigned from the parish council and Mike Ramaekers has filled the vacant seat based on the previous election results.

A proposal has been made to install a different doorbell system at the entrance of the parish office. Fr. Stan will consult with the parish secretary and the bookkeeper for additional clarification regarding this request.

The Archdiocesan Annual Appeal envelopes and cards will be distributed in the near future.

We will be going to the winter Mass schedule for Saturday evenings starting November 2. Holy Family, Lindsay-Mass will be held at 4 PM and St. Francis, Humphrey-Mass will be at 6:15 PM respectively, and St. Michael's, Tarnov Mass time is TBD.

#### **PASTOR'S REPORT:**

December 9 is a holy day of obligation, the Immaculate Conception.

At the request of several inquiries, Fr. Stan clarified that St. Francis Church, St. Francis Grade School and Archangels Catholic High School are three separate legal entities.

Fr. Stan is arranging dates for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and the accompanying retreat for the second grade parents.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 19, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:29 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

## St. Francis of Assisi Parish Finance Board Meeting Minutes October 30, 2024

The meeting of the finance board opened with prayer led by Fr. Stan Schmit at 6:01 PM on Wednesday, October 30, 2024. President, Bryan Reichmuth, called the meeting to order.

Roll call was taken. Those present were Fr. Stan, Lisa Krings, Kevin Small, Ashley Krings, David Wegener, Carol Wemhoff, Brent Reichmuth, Bryan Reichmuth, Tim Werner, Dan Fehringer and Deb Herchenbach. Spencer Eisenmenger was excused.

Fiscal year-to-date financial reports were reviewed by board members prior to the meeting and approved.

Bazaar results were reviewed. The count for meals sold was determined to be inaccurate and will not be published. The office is waiting for the remaining bills to be submitted before the numbers will be finalized.

#### Pastor's Report

Fr. Stan informed the board one of our CD's at Bank of Lindsay came due and was renewed for another twelve month: the rate is down slightly. Fr. Stan also informed the board that he is considering the potential need for an additional principal or assistant principal for the elementary as enrollment numbers continue to increase. There is also consideration of bringing the Pre-K into the school system. Currently it operates independently but utilizes a classroom in the school. Pre-K as part of the school system increases the requirements on the program, which would be additional responsibility on the principal as well.

An update was given from McKenzie Eisenmann on the work being done at the daycare covered under the grant. During the approved renovations there was unexpected repairs that had to be made due to a water leak and subsequent mold. She will have to use general operating funds to cover a portion of these repairs, as the guidelines in the grant do not allow the daycare to change how the funds in the grant are used.

Fr. Stan reminded the board about the Archbishop's Annual Appeal. Envelopes are provided in the pews of church for families to give what they can. Fr. Stan asked that, at minimum, everyone pray for the success of the appeal if they are unable to make a financial contribution.

Money collected from second collections for Catholic education will be collected in December from the other parishes. A member of the board asked Fr. Stan to ensure this is being done in all parishes consistently. Fr. will have a discussion with each of the parishes.

The subsidy from Holy Family parish for Archangels are due in ten installments of \$10,000 each. The first installment of \$10,000 was received and \$5,000 of the second installment. Father will be following up on the remaining amount.

The board will continue with quarterly meetings. It was decided that the next meeting would be scheduled at the beginning of the calendar year.
