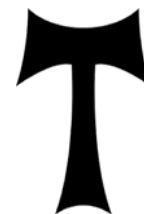

Dear Parishioners,

I am sure most of us have heard that we have entered the Church Jubilee Year, which happens every 25 years. The Pope proclaimed this Jubilee Year as a Year of Hope! Yes, we are “Pilgrims of Hope”. It will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war and the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Holy Father is calling on all Catholics to renew their Hope in Christ. On Christmas Eve, at the beginning of Mass, the Holy Father pushed open the Holy Doors on St. Peter’s Basilica, which will stay open the entire year so pilgrims may pass through. Those who participate in the Jubilee Year can obtain indulgences. An indulgence is the removal of “temporal” punishment for sin that may remain.

A Jubilee Year is a time set aside by the Church to encourage the faithful to embark on pilgrimages, to repent of our sins and forgive others who have harmed us in some fashion, thus we can renew our focus on our spiritual life. As a special year of grace and forgiveness, it offers the faithful an opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence. If you want more information, simply look online dealing with indulgences for this Jubilee Year. The Holy Door of Saint Peter’s will close on January 6, 2026, the Feast of the Epiphany. (A side note: There will be an extraordinary Jubilee Year again in 2033 the 2,000th Anniversary Year of Jesus’ death.)

Our own Archdiocese, presided over by our archbishop, along with every diocese throughout the world, opened the Jubilee Year with a special celebration on December 29. One can read about it in the Catholic Voice on-line. There are at least six sites one can visit within our archdiocese in celebration of this Jubilee Year and gain an indulgence if they follow the prescribed norms set by the Church (prayers, etc).
