Dear Parishioners,

As we prepare to begin a New Year, there are so many things that come to mind: What will my New Year's resolution be, and will I be able to keep it?

We celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. We are reminded that she is also our mother. What a wonderful thing to know, that we are also Mary's children. As we reflect upon this, it may take us to the moral reality of children, birth and the right to life. On January 22 we remember and pray to God that we might respect all life, from the moment of conception to our moment of natural death when we leave this life and return to the Father.

Ever since the early 1990's, I have taught about the right to life in a logical way, as it is logical to believe in life. Just think of it who say a woman has a right to an abortion really don't understand rights. Rights are given to us by God, not just society, and society doesn't have the moral primacy that God's law or natural law have in and of itself. A person has the right to have relations or not, this is a truth and a reality. The result of having relations can have consequences of the actions one has freely taken. I use to tie this whole idea into the aspect of if one commit's a crime and then goes to prison or some other consequence as a result of their free-will choice (action). One does not get to choose whether they accept this consequence; it is given, and they have no choice. This is true of all of life. The free will choices we make in our daily lives do have consequences, and we need to accept them.

This last November we voted on constitutional language to help begin protecting the life of the unborn, and we should continue to move forward in this important moral issue. So as we move through this month of January, the month in which we celebrate, so many times, the importance and sacredness of life, let us pray for the softening of hearts to follow God's purpose that all life is sacred from the miraculous moment of conception to the natural ending of death.

The minutes stand approved as written. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Steve Wieser and seconded by Doug Eisenmenger.

#### **Old Business:**

Four rows of cement slabs were installed this fall at the St. Francis Cemetery.

The Knights of Columbus donated funds towards the storage shed at St. Francis Cemetery.

#### New Business:

Reviewed the price per cemetery plots. There will be no price increase at any of our cemeteries.

Thrasher has been contacted to give us an estimate on what the cost would be to level some monuments that are leaning at our cemeteries. We will see if it is a feasible cost.

Carl Jarosz will help with snow removal at our cemeteries.

Looking at possibilities to keep the dirt and rock in separate bins next to the storage shed.

It is our goal that by June 2025 the dirt pile near the top of the new acre area will be moved to the storage shed area.

The board has discussed the need for a volunteer to help Doug Eisenmenger in marking graves, etc. at the St. Francis Cemetery. If anyone is willing to help please contact a board member.

This upcoming spring a load of rock will be needed at St. Francis Cemetery.

The board discussed what we have for finances.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM with a prayer lead by Fr. Stan Schmit.
