

Dear Parishioners,

Vacation. During the summer many families take a vacation to get away and do something together without the hustle and bustle of work or school - though that doesn't seem to be the case around here. We as men and women, girls and boys need the down time to rejuvenate. During summertime many tend to take a brake from going to Church and many parishes suffer because of it.

I ran across an old story that I think explains the importance of vacation but not taking a vacation from our God/Faith.

St. John, the Bishop of Ephesus, had a tame partridge that he liked to play with now and then. One day a hunter stopped by to see the bishop and saw him playing with his pet partridge. "I'm surprised to see you playing with that bird," said the hunter. Pointing to the bows and arrows carried by the hunter, St. John asked; "Why do you unbend your bow when you are not hunting?" "Because if it was kept strung, it would lose its force," replied the hunter. "It's the same with human beings," explained the bishop. "A man must relax his mind with some innocent amusement, otherwise it would break under the work and cares of everyday life."

That is the reason we have vacation - to refresh the body, the mind and the soul. I would like to say, though, that there is never any vacation from God, or at least there shouldn't be. God is always thinking of us, even during vacation; we, in turn, must think of God, even during vacation.

Going to Mass each weekend is very important in that we need God's graces then more than ever as more free time gives the devil more chances to tempt us. Likewise we should pray every day, at least an Our Father and a Hail Mary asking for their assistance in our daily life. It only takes a minute. We can then thank God for His blessings and the good times we are having. Maybe even take a few minutes to read the Bible and reflect on how you can better live out Jesus' words.

Going to Confession and receiving Holy Communion is so important - we need God's life, received through the sacraments, to lead us to Him. I think of it this way: Suppose for three months we would eat nothing; would not move a muscle; would not speak a word to anyone. Something would be wrong, seriously wrong. Spiritually there is something seriously wrong when we do not eat the Food of Life for three months, nor talk to God in prayer.

Let us then, during these summer months, have a pleasant, refreshing, healthy vacation to build up both our body and our soul.

# St. Francis of Assisi Parish Finance Board Meeting Minutes May 25, 2024

The meeting of the finance board opened with prayer led by Fr. Stan Schmit at 8:00 AM on Saturday, May 25, 2024. President, Bryan Reichmuth, called the meeting to order.

Roll call was taken. Those present were Fr. Stan, Lisa Krings, Kevin Small, David Wegener, Carol Wemhoff, Brent Reichmuth, Bryan Reichmuth, Ashley Krings and Dan Fehringer. Tim Werner and Spencer Eisenmenger were excused. Deb Herchenbach was welcomed as a guest from the Archangels finance team.

Fiscal year-to-date financial reports were reviewed and approved. Ashley Krings made a motion to approve the financials and Kevin Small seconded the motion; all were in favor.

School tuition payment contacts were updated. Brent Reichmuth and Fr. Stan reported from the school board that the tuition contracts are being updated to change the statement about past tuition and to take steps to implement the repercussions.

Fr. Stan reported on the funding models for Archangels Catholic. He will also be starting a second collection in each parish at least two times a month for Catholic education to be shared by all three elementary schools and the high school in our parish family.

It was decided that Deb Herchenbach would continue to attend the finance board meetings.

The bylaws were reviewed. It was decided that the board would review the bylaws in more depth after hearing Fr. Stan's commented we will make the amendment recommendations at the next meeting.

The new associate pastor will be announced at Mass this weekend.

Fr. Stan explained that he intends to bring together the parish family with some boards that will help relieve some of his burden.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 18, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting closed with a prayer at 9:45 AM.

### St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes June 3, 2024

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:05 PM on Monday, June 3, 2024. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Erik Baumgart, Spencer Eisenmenger, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Katie McPhillips, Tim Werner, Steve Wieser and Kari Wieseler. Brad Stallbaumer was excused.

The minutes from the April 16, 2024, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

Guest, Lori Classen, St. Francis director of religious education, was present to introduce Makenzie Kurtenbach, a 7<sup>th</sup> grade PRE student. Mrs. Classen announced to Fr. Stan and the parish council that Mackenzie was the first place recipient among all submissions in the Omaha Archdiocese for her pro-life essay.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### **School Board:**

The school received a \$2,000 grant that will go towards a camera for the school entrance facing the parking lot.

At the time of the meeting, there has only been one application for the open school board position.

The current math curriculum is will be transitioning from Saxon math to Expressions over the next couple years. The kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade classes will begin using the new curriculum this fall. Followed by 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade the following year. This will continue for all K-6 grade levels.

The school has begun using the new TADs system for school registration and tuition agreements for the 2024-25 school year.

In regards to Pre-K enrollment, there has been little interest from parents in opening up a Tuesday/Thursday program at this time. In addition, Mrs. Ramaekers has interest in pursuing her teaching certificate/bachelor's degree in early childhood. A certified teacher in early childhood would be needed if the PreK program came under the operation of the elementary school.

#### **Finance Board:**

It was stated that contributions are currently down 10% year-to-date, but are trending up, and that gap is narrowing in comparison to December numbers.

#### **Development:**

There was a good turnout at the alumni banquet. There was discussion held by the development board to potentially move the banquet date so it does not fall on the same weekend at state track,

but moving away from the holiday weekend historically did not generate as good of a turnout, so it will likely not be changed.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Complete Floors was contacted for a quote to replace the carpet in the church so this can be put into a future budget. The current carpet style is not available, so the plan is to quote several different options of a similar color and style. Another company was called in order to compare quotes and propose these amounts to the parish council for approval.

Dan Fehringer looked into the cost to replace the light bulbs in the church and received a quote of \$.83/bulb to purchase replacement bulbs, and we have a donor who is willing to pay for them. There are 970 total light bulbs in the church, and approval was given to proceed with the purchase of incandescent bulbs. Coordination of replacement of the bulbs is on hold until quotes for the carpet come in for approval.

There were no updates at the time of the meeting regarding the parish family parish pictorial.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Fr. Matt's farewell gathering will be held on Sunday, June 9, 2024, at 11 AM in the school gymnasium.

Fr. Stan will be celebrating his 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary to the priesthood on June 23 at 1 PM in the parish hall.

#### **PASTOR'S REPORT:**

Fr. Matt will be leaving on June 13 for his new assignment, and the new associate pastor, Fr. Dan Wittrock, will be arriving on July 1. Fr. Dan is currently serving in the Creighton and Bloomfield area.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 22, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:36 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.
