<u>St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes</u> <u>April 16, 2024</u>

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:01 PM on Tuesday, April 16, 2024. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Erik Baumgart, Spencer Eisenmenger, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Katie McPhillips, Bryan Reichmuth, Steve Wieser and Kari Wieseler. Brad Stallbaumer was excused.

The minutes from the March 4, 2024, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

Since the last report, there were two school board meetings and the following was reported:

All teacher positions have been filled for the 2024-25 school year. New high school teachers include: Mr. Bret Atkins, Mr. Travis Willnerd and Mr. Jon Krings. Mrs. Danielle Bender has been hired as an aide in the elementary school.

The school has purchased a new communication platform to replace Sycamore. The new TAD's system will be implemented before the next school year.

Mrs. Dunn shared the ACT scores. They were reviewed by the school board and all are keeping their eyes on opportunities for increased scores.

Mrs. Ramaekers has a very strong turnout for preschool open house. Due to the preschool being an independent entity, the class size must be capped at 20 students. Since the number exceeded this amount, they are trying to find ways to accept additional students (potentially offering a rotating schedule, etc.). With the anticipated future numbers, the option of St. Francis helping with the preschool program is being explored to accommodate the larger class sizes.

Rebecca Classen is stepping down from her position in the cafeteria, and the school is currently seeking a replacement.

First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday, April 21, 2024.

Approval was given to have the student activity pass of \$25/student to be added upon registration.

Tuition rates for the 2024-25 school year are as follows:

- Kindergarten \$2,800
- Grades 1-4 \$3,400
- Grades 5-6 \$3,600
- Grades 7-12 \$3,800

Finance Board:

Discussion was held on the lag of revenue, and preliminary reports show that March bounced back slightly.

Finance board discussed the future of the elementary versus high school budget.

Given the current situation of the boiler, Bryan Reichmuth was able to locate a used boiler (2002 model) that will work for both the high school and grade school in the event one of them ends up in disrepair.

Development:

Alumni banquet planning is in progress.

Proceeds from the Pizza, Puzzles and Pints event as well as a donation from the Knights of Columbus, Bank of Lindsay, and individual parishioners, Mrs. Tina Schumacher also designated some remaining funds from her parents (Ed & Florice Boesch) estate to help with the purchase of a total of 70 new tables was made from Werner's Do It Best Hardware at a very generous price. The hope is to have them in time for the Alumni Banquet, but they will for sure be available for use in time for the parish bazaar.

OLD BUSINESS:

Carpets were spot cleaned by Jim Wemhoff, and a few of the spots look much better. Dan Fehringer and Steve Wieser were able to mend the seam that showed some of the wear. Kari Wieseler is planning to contact Complete Floors for a quote to replace the carpet so this can be worked into a future budget.

A copier for the parish office has been purchased.

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion was held and pamphlets were passed around regarding a parish cluster pictorial. Covid interfered with our previous attempt, so the council agreed that having a company come in to organize and put together a parish pictorial would be worth looking into.

A member of the 500 Club committee proposed a couple of different ideas for approval for next year's event. The parish council gave the approval to move forward.

The lights in the church need new bulbs in several areas. Several items to consider were discussed, and Dan Fehringer will look into what it would cost for a full replacement of the lights where possible.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

The summer Mass schedule for Saturday evening Mass has been determined: 5 PM-St. Francis of Assisi, Humphrey; 6 PM-St. Michael's, Tarnov; and 7 PM-Holy Family Parish, Lindsay.

A question was asked in regards to the status of building a new school or potentially acquiring the Humphrey Public School facilities. At the time of the meeting, Fr. Stan is waiting for Archdiocesan approval from the CFO.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 16, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.




