Dear Parishioners.

The weather has switched from cold and snowy to unseasonably warm. It can get one thinking of Spring, but spiritually it can make one reflect on the season of Lent, which we are about to enter. Lent is that season of the Church year that makes us not only reflect upon our relationship with God, but also has us reflect upon our sins, heaven and hell. Heaven, of course, peace and joyfulness (cool); hell, then, as we all know, is that place of punishment and fire (heat).

The Church gives us the season of Lent to reconnect with God in a special way, giving us out-of-the-ordinary spiritual encounters through the stations of the cross, extra times of reconciliation, 24- hour adoration of our Lord in the Eucharist along with (special) times of fasting and abstinence.

Ash Wednesday begins the preparation for this season, though not a holy day, everyone tends to attend Mass and receive ashes. The ashes come from burned palms from the previous year and are to remind us that "we are dust and unto dust we shall return". We so often forget this simple fact, that we will die and turn to dust. It is God who sustains us and gives us eternal life through the death and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ. We owe all to Him. Ash Wednesday is likewise a day of fasting and abstinence for us Catholics. Those age 18-59 eating only one meal (fasting) and age 14 until death eating no meat (abstinence). This also is the regulation for Good Friday, the time of our Lord's death. Fasting, especially, is meant to help us get in touch with longing to follow Christ more closely and is to help us change our lives when it comes to that sin of PRIDE. Abstinence is required also on all Friday's of Lent though many people do the old tradition of Fridays all year long in order to spiritually connect them to Jesus and His death.

The Stations of the Cross, though can be prayed any day of the year, are held on the Fridays of Lent at 7 PM either in Humphrey or Lindsay along with 6 PM in Leigh or Clarkson, one would need to check the bulletin to find out where they are being held. The stations put us in touch with the passion of our Lord Jesus and help us understand the suffering He went through to save us from our sins.

The sacrament of reconciliation is our way of having our sins forgiven and being open to the fullness of God's grace that is offered to us. During Lent we offer more opportunities for this sacrament so that people have the option of receiving God's grace so they may truly experience His peace and love in their heart and soul.

Something new this year for Lent, maybe beyond, is that of having adoration 24/7 in our parish community. This came about, not through us priests, but rather well-spring of prayer and unity with God from different parishioners. They felt the calling of God in their heart, through their own time in adoration, to show honor and love for Christ in the Eucharist through inviting parishioners of our parish to spend time with the Lord and likewise experience His presence in our midst. You can find out more about this beautiful way of honoring our Lord in the bulletin.

As we travel through this holy season of Lent, may we remember each other in prayer that God may strengthen our faith and unite us more closely to Him and one another within this community.

St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes January 8, 2025

The meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:05 PM on Wednesday, January 8, 2025. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Spencer Eisenmenger, Erik Baumgart, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Michael Ramaekers, Kari Wieseler and Bryan Reichmuth. Steve Wieser and Ann Olmer were excused.

The minutes from the November 26, 2024, meeting were reviewed and approved except for a change to the Confirmation retreat date. The retreat will be held on February 23, 2025, at 12:45, PM and Confirmation Mass will be held on March 23, 2025, at 2 PM. Minutes were otherwise approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

There has not been a school board meeting since the last update.

Finance Board:

There has not been a finance board meeting since the last update.

Development:

It was reiterated that the Blue and White Night 2024 was the second highest net profit on record next to 2023, so many thanks to all who attended this event. The alumni newsletter is in process and should be sent out during the week of January 20.

OLD BUSINESS:

No new updates in regards to St. Francis Preschool or safe environment training at this time.

In regard to the parish pictorial, a representative is still needed from Clarkson in order to proceed.

Discussion was held regarding the current ACHS school board. It was noted that the transition team is serving as the Archangels school board and that school boards for both the elementary and high school are meeting on a 4-6 week cadence. Fr. Stan also confirmed that any change to building improvements are still currently on hold with the Archdiocese.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was discussion regarding the charter bus. Erik Baumgart mentioned the possibility of a donor willing to rebrand the bus. Concerns were raised with the bus situation since we are no longer able to utilize the Humphrey Public buses to transport kids to events. The repairs approved in a previous council meeting have been completed, and costs came in below the budgeted amount.

A suggestion was made that there might be a need to communicate additional evangelization opportunities within our parish and a potential interest in bus trips, speakers, etc. for our parishioners to attend.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Christmas Masses went well; however, there may be an adjustment to the 5:30 PM Christmas Eve Mass to accommodate the drive time for the priests.

Catholic Schools Week is planned for the end of January.

The Confirmation retreat is scheduled for February 23, 2025, at 12:45 PM.

There are a couple of special upcoming opportunities available for our parish family in the month of February. The Blessing of the Throats will be offered after Masses the weekend of February 1 and 2. The Anointing of Sick will be available after Mass during the weekend of February 15 and 16.

PRE classes have resumed since the break.

A First Communion parent meeting will be held on February 5, 2025, at 7 PM.

Ash Wednesday is coming up on March 5, 2025.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 13, 2025, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 7:55 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

Referees have asked if fans could not stand against the wall next to the court due to safety concerns, especially for the kids. We will try to watch this as much as we can.


Clarkson/Leigh hosted the Defenders this month and served a nice "super" nacho bar. This is something we would like to have for one of our upcoming track meets.

All are invited to join us!



Perpetual Adoration For Lent March 5-April 20

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament comes easily. Never feel worried if you find you have no thoughts at all while you are before the Blessed Sacrament. Never feel inadequate about being an adorer even if you have not developed a spirit of devotion, are down and out, weakened by life. The all-important factor is that you are before the Lord. Before Him who knows you inside out. He reads your innermost thoughts, and He still loves you immensely. Imagine that! St. John Vianney once compared adoration to spiritual sunbathing. You are taking in the warmth of the grace and love radiating from the Sacred Host.
