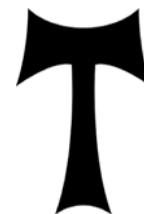

Dear Parishioners,

What have you given up for Lent? That is a question I have been asked by school student's a fair amount since Lent has begun. It used to be that like many people, I gave up candy, pop or other things I found enjoyable. A few years ago I decided to do something different. During Lent I try to do something to improve on my relationship with God, such as spending more time in prayer, making it a point to spend an hour in Adoration each day or whatever area needs improving to strengthen that relationship. No one is perfect. So Lent gives me the opportunity to get back to the basics. In doing something along this line I can then come to better see where God is leading me and what in my own life needs to change or be transformed so I am more like Him, being His faithful servant.

In talking about the season of Lent with the school kids I offer other little tidbits that some people don't know, such as, how do we determine when Easter will be or like this year the Feast of the Annunciation falls on the Monday of Holy Week, meaning it can't be celebrated that day and ends up being transferred to April 8. I likewise speak of the Sacred or Paschal Triduum. How Holy Thursday through the Easter Vigil is one whole in the eyes of the Church and how in some ways the Funeral Rites mirror this holy event. I try to tell them about each day and it's importance. Lent itself is a great teaching tool when it comes to our Faith.

As we sojourn through this Lenten season, let us keep one another in prayer and may Easter be a time of New Beginnings and Rejoicing.

St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes
January 29, 2024

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the secretary, Kari Wieseler, at 7:00 PM on Monday, January 29, 2024. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Sarah Kessler, Dan Fehringer, Katie McPhillips, Spencer Eisenmenger, Steve Wieser, Brad Stallbaumer and Kari Wieseler. Erik Baumgart and Bryan Reichmuth were excused.

The minutes from the November 21, 2023, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

School Board:

Pejay Padrigon has arrived and begun teaching at St. Francis.

At the start of the second semester, we welcomed two new students, Shelby and Milo Korth.

Mrs. Dunn has obtained a new copier for the high school.

Teachers and coaches will receive 2024-25 offers/contracts in March.

Boiler quotes are in process by Mrs. Dunn. A temporary boiler option will be proposed to the school board at the next meeting.

With St. Francis 7-12 closing at the end of the school year, the Len and Adele Hassenstab Endowment has been amended to provide for the earning to be evenly split between St. Francis School and Archangels Catholic High School.

Finance Board:

Sunday collections are down. The board needs to see this trend reverse in order to avoid having to look at additional funding and action.

Development:

Blue and White Night final numbers were unavailable at the time of the meeting. A new record was set for 2023.

The alumni newsletter has been sent out.

OLD BUSINESS:

Quotes for carpet cleaning and past expenses related to replacement were presented to the parish council. Jim Wemhoff quoted \$2,350 to clean the north entryway and stairs, all carpets in the church, east stairs, landing, etc. Quote to clean, with additional spot cleaning, was approved by the

council. Kari Wieseler will follow up with Karen Wieser on potential dates to complete the cleaning prior to Easter.

NEW BUSINESS:

Due to the absence of several members, the election of officers was postponed to the next meeting.

Fr. Stan discussed the need for a buzz-in security system for the parish office. The council approved to go ahead with quoting this type of system.

There is a need for a new color copier in the rectory. Fr. presented quotes to the council for both purchase and lease options. Questions regarding the lease option and potential service contract were presented to Fr. Stan to bring back to the rectory personnel for further discussion.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Regarding the parish and parish families, Fr. Stan feels that things are moving in the right direction.

Final touches are being decided on Holy Week Masses. Ash Wednesday and Lenten Masses have been set with Stations of the Cross planned for the typical Fridays at 7 PM.

At the time of the meeting, the plan for graduation is to stay in the Church.

Current steps with the school merger include the submission of names and mascots to the Archbishop. Results are expected during the first week of February. Next steps potentially include a design committee, etc., depending on what decision is made.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 4, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

Finance Board Meeting Minutes
January 25, 2024

The meeting of the finance board opened with prayer led by Fr. Stan Schmit at 7:11 PM on Thursday, January 25, 2024. President, Bryan Reichmuth, called the meeting to order.

Roll call was taken. Those present were Fr. Stan, Lisa Krings, Kevin Small, Ashley Krings, David Wegener, Carol Wemhoff, Brent Reichmuth and Tim Werner. Dan Fehringer was absent.

Fiscal year-to-date financial reports were reviewed and approved.

Staff wage increases for the 2024/2025 school year were reviewed, and a motion was made by Kevin Small and seconded by Tim Werner for a 4% increase. The discussion regarding tuition rates was tabled until a future meeting.

The board reviewed the decision from 2020 to phase out tuition discount that was previously offered to teachers. The phase out was to prevent a teacher from losing a benefit they were currently receiving.

Fr. Stan informed the board that he will be suspending the combined board that was formed to research the feasibility of building a new grade school until the Archbishop can provide direction. He will be selecting members from both communities to look at building a high school but will not be disbanding the elementary group because the cost of building a high school could be significantly higher.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 19, 2024, at 7 PM

The meeting closed with a prayer at 8:55 PM.

February 12, 2024

The St. Francis school board met on Monday, February 12, 2024, in the St. Francis rectory. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Mrs. Jennifer Dunn, Katie McPhillips, Diane Noonan, Ann Olmer, Todd Preister, Brent Reichmuth and Jared Wiehn.

Todd Preister opened the meeting with a prayer.

Brent Reichmuth read a thank you letter from student Eli Zach to the board for our time and effort on the school board.

The minutes of last month's meeting were approved by Jared Wiehn and seconded by Todd Preister.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

Administrator's Report:

Parent/Teacher Conferences went well. Parents attend spring conferences less in the spring than in the fall. However, parental participation was lower than typical spring conferences.

Mrs. Dunn is starting to work on next year's school calendar.

Questions have arisen about snow days so far this year and any possible make up days. She explained that instructional hours necessary to complete the year are being tallied and appear to be on track.

Teacher contracts will be sent out a little earlier this year, mid-February, and will be due early March.

Finances:

Fr. Stan noted that family parishes with students attending Archangels High School will help subsidize their tuition. Efforts to collect unpaid tuition falls under the finance boards jurisdiction and they are discussing possible actions.

President's Comments:

With the new name and mascot of the united high school decided, much work needs to be done in the next months to be ready for the fall school year. Committees are being named by the transition team and committee members will be gathered in the very near future.

A group of new servers will soon be ready to serve at Masses.

New Business:

We as a board asked how to best support our teachers during this transition to the new school. Fr. Stan reported that starting this fall, the current St. Francis school board would become the St. Francis Elementary school board. The new Archangels High School school board will consist of the transition team for the first year of operation. After that, Fr. Stan wants to revert to the voting process to assemble members of the finance board, school board and parish council. Fr. Stan would still appoint the two trustees, per Canon Law.

A 4% increase to base salaries to keep up with inflation was announced.

Old Business:

A parent requested an addendum to the handbook to include a blockout time period for students to wear shorts to school. It was suggested to table that decision.

The grade school handbook was distributed in order to suggest updates for it at the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned with a prayer led by Brent Reichmuth at 8:10 PM.

The next meeting of the school board will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, at 7 PM.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 18, 2024, at 7 PM.

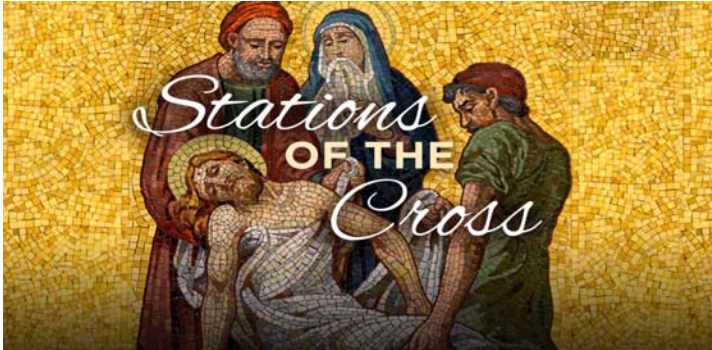
