

Dear Parishioners,

The month of May has much activity - possibly one of the busiest months of the year, but we do need to pause and thank God for two very important women, who are honored of this month. In May we celebrate Mother's Day and it is the month of Mary, our Blessed Mother. A little bit about each.

There is a story about the Battle of Manila Bay in 1896 when the American Navy, under Admiral Dewey, defeated the Spanish fleet. As the order was given to clear the deck for action, the coat of an American sailor blew overboard. Permission to go after it was refused. Nevertheless, the sailor jumped into the swirling sea and saved his coat. For disobeying orders he was sentenced to several years in prison.

Admiral Dewey ordered the lad brought before him and asked the reason for such open disobedience. Somewhat embarrassed, the lad pulled a photograph from the inside pocket of his coat and handed it to the admiral with these words: "My mother!"

The sailor explained that he always carried his mother's picture. His first and only thought was to save that picture. Admiral Dewey smiled and declared: "Sons who, for the picture of their mother, risk their lives are also willing to give their lives for their country; they do not have to be imprisoned like criminals."

Every one of us carries a picture of his or her mother in their heart. We honor and love our mothers because of the love they showed us. They brought us into the world; fed, nursed, clothed and bathed us. They watched over us, taking care of us when we were ill or injured. They sacrificed many comforts and even necessities so that you and I could have what we needed.

Our mother, likewise, made every effort to do good to our souls. She taught us to make the sign of the cross; to say our prayers; to be unselfish, obedient, honest and pure. She taught us about God and His Blessed Mother.

The Blessed Mother is not only the mother of Jesus, but also our Mother. The beauty of Mary's soul was her true glory and attractiveness. She had the virtues in their highest degree. In the Litany of the Blessed Virgin, we call her all the beautiful names we can think of. Think of her qualities of mind and heart, and you will realize how sweet and saintly was the soul of Mary.

All this beauty of soul and body draws us to her. It makes us want to show our appreciation, our admiration. We smother her altar with flowers showing our love, but more pleasing still to her is when we offer her the flowers of our devotion and our prayers.

St. Francis of Assisi School Board Minutes April 11, 2024

The St. Francis school board met on Thursday, April 11, 2024, at 7:00 PM in the St. Francis parish office meeting room. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Mrs. Jennifer Dunn, Katie McPhillips, Diane Noonan, Ann Olmer, Todd Preister, Brent Reichmuth and Jared Wiehn.

Jared Wiehn opened the meeting with a prayer.

Brent Reichmuth welcomed Natalie Ramaekers to the meeting. Natalie Ramaekers is the preschool director and was present to answer questions about the preschool and its enrollment.

The St. Francis preschool is not operated under the school administration and is instead privately operated but allowed to use a classroom in the elementary building. Questions arose regarding preschool enrollment being capped. Natalie explained that the limit for preschool is 20 students and that she accepts students based on the order the applications are received. The board discussed the benefits and disadvantages of creating a preschool that would be governed by St. Francis administration. This would require a certified teacher and would also need to follow other Rule 11 regulations. Mrs. Dunn will look into these regulations more. It was decided to table this discussion until the next meeting.

The meeting agenda was approved by Diane Noonan and seconded by Todd Preister.

The minutes of last month's meeting were approved by Katie McPhillips and seconded by Jared Wiehn.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

Administrator's Report:

Mrs. Dunn reported that Danielle Bender will replace Kim Jarosz as the elementary para.

Seventeen students showed up for Kindergarten Round-Up.

Next year's calendar is close to being finalized.

We are still in need of a new school lunch program director.

Finances:

Fr. Stan noted that he would like to see Sunday contributions increase.

Tuition has been set for next year:

- Kindergarten \$2,800
- Grades 1-4 \$3,400
- Grades 5-6 \$3,600

• Grades 7-12 - \$3,800

President's Comments:

Fr. Stan enjoys his time in the classrooms. The second graders seem to be ready for next week's First Holy Communion.

Fr. Stan is pleased that all teaching positions are filled.

Fr. Stan plans for the Archangels High School (ACHS) students to participate in more outreach activities to allow students to live out their faith through service.

The vision/culture committee has many good ideas.

School board elections for St. Francis Grade School will be held in late May. A notice will be in the bulletin asking people to apply. Interested people will need to:

- 1. Meet with Fr. Stan.
- 2. Write why they want to be a school board member.
- 3. Write their goals for the school board.

The ACHS school board will consist of the transition team for the first year.

New Business:

Sycamore is being replaced by TADS and Educate, a more streamlined school computer program. HSF, ACHS and LHF will use and be able to handle enrollment, grades, tuition, communication, lunch payments, calendars and other administrative tasks. TADS and Educate is being used in the New York Catholic school system and is being piloted by schools in the Omaha Archdiocese schools.

The athletic board proposed a \$25 student activity pass that would allow admittance to all home activities except district games. This fee would be charged during enrollment. This would simplify the ticket takers' job, potentially save money for large families and hopefully increase attendance at activities. The transition team approved it for ACHS. A discussion was held as to whether to add this to the K-6 school for next year. The results of the vote for adding this to the K-6 school was 5-1. The motion passed.

A letter to be sent to surrounding families of potential ACHS students is being planned.

The St. Francis website will continue to serve the K-6 school next year.

A new website is being built for ACHS.

Wednesday, April 17, a meeting of all family parishes finance boards will meet with an Archdiocese representative.

There have been requests for transition team meeting minutes to be publicized.

Old Business:

A used boiler has been purchased for use in either the high school or grade school. Bryan Reichmuth will pick up the boiler that was once used as a kiln in a brick making plant. Many thanks to the alert parishioner who found it on an online auction site.

The next meeting of the school board will be held on May 21, 2024, at 7 PM.

The meeting was adjourned with a prayer led by Jared Wiehn at 8:45 PM.

Brent Reichmuth was excused. Guests present were Brandi Eisenmenger and Kenzie Eisenmann from Little Saints Daycare and Deb Herchenbach from the Archangels Transition Team finance board.

Little Saints representatives presented the budget for the upcoming year and discussed the \$250,000 grant they have applied for which would be used for updates and program improvements. It cannot be used for general operating expenses. They presented a balanced budget for 24/25 fiscal year rate increases will cover anticipated wage increases resulting from the minimum wages changes. The board asked Kenzie Eisenmann, our new daycare director, to consider attending the meeting quarterly.

Financial statements were reviewed.

Funding of Archangels Catholic was discussed. For this current fiscal year, until Fr. Stan can provide any confirmed commitments from other parishes, the board decided to include the entire deficit for ACHS in the St. Francis Church budget.

Because of the increase deficit, Bryan Reichmuth wanted to go on the record as finance board president that he would recommend holding off on spending any money on uniforms or other items that need to be rebranded, regardless of whether the money is donated or not, even if that means we must compete in uniforms that have a different name on them for the coming season to show we are being conscientious and conservative in our processes.

Fr. Stan made his closing comments.
