# St. Francis of Assisi Parish Pastoral Council Minutes March 11, 2025

The meeting of the parish pastoral council was called to order by the president, Spencer Eisenmenger, at 7:10 PM on Thursday, March 11, 2025. Fr. Stan led the opening prayer. Members present were Fr. Stan Schmit, Spencer Eisenmenger, Erik Baumgart, Dan Fehringer, Sarah Kessler, Ann Olmer, Michael Ramaekers, Bryan Reichmuth, Steve Wieser and Kari Wieseler.

The minutes from the February 13, 2025, meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### **St. Francis School Board:**

A motion was approved to move the preschool under the St. Francis School.

Mrs. Dunn discussed the need for an additional kindergarten teacher as well as student resource/guidance counselor for the grade school due to the increasing student enrollment. This topic will be discussed with the finance board to obtain their recommendation/approval.

Updates to the handbook for the 2025/26 school year are in progress.

Representatives from the Archdiocese of Omaha will be doing an on-site walk-through of the grade school campus on February 28, 2025, to assess the need for a new grade school or additional options.

#### **Finance Board:**

Approval was received for a separate finance board for Little Saints Daycare.

Sunday collection funds were up at the time of the last review.

Teacher salaries and tuition recommendations have been made.

There was discussion around the need for all items needing finance approval to be presented to the finance board prior to being presented to the parish pastoral council for approval. This will be the process going forward.

#### **Development:**

Nothing new to report at the time of the meeting.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Bob Preister fixed the pipe in the grade school bathroom and believes the floor drains are ok but raised concerns that there may be a need for additional cleaning of the bathrooms. Fr. Stan will be

reviewing the contract with the cleaning company and evaluating the need for additional resources in cleaning this area of the facility.

A quote was obtained for a new base coat and top layer for the roof repair. There is also the potential to submit claims for damage to the roof. It was mentioned that the roof above the rectory also needs attention, so Erik is going to obtain quotes to repair this as well. Once the entire roof has been assessed, this will be discussed further and presented to the finance board if needed.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Jim Stolz and representatives from the Archdiocese as well as members of the school board and finance board toured the church, daycare, high school and grade school. It was agreed upon that repairing the grade school is not a worthwhile investment, and feedback was given to start moving forward with looking at future options for this building. Mr. Stolz was going to give his feedback to the Archbishop and report back to Fr. Stan.

The concern was raised regarding the need to do something about the drainage issue at the high school. This will be added to a project list as something to look into further. There was mention that the gutters may need to be looked at as well. Kari Wieseler will turn in a maintenance request to Ron to look into this and ask that he add it as a routinely-scheduled task.

Discussion was held regarding the previous mention of Fr. Wayne's garden behind the high school. The council recalled the approval to clean up this area, but are unsure if this was completed. Kari Wieseler will also turn in a maintenance request to ensure this is added to a project list to be cleaned up.

#### **PASTOR'S REPORT:**

Confirmation for our Family of God parish cluster is set for Sunday, March 23, at 2 PM. Confirmation practice will be held on Wednesday, March 19, at 7 PM, and Fr. Stan will try to incorporate confessions during this time as well.

There is a First Communion parent meeting on March 26 at 7 PM for those who were unable to attend the first meeting.

Going forward, there will be a more detailed agenda provided by the parish council president prior to the parish council meetings, and these will be the items discussed. Spencer Eisenmenger, the parish council president, also discussed the need for the bylaws to be updated, as they are outdated.

The next meeting is scheduled for April 10, 2025, at 7 PM.

The meeting adjourned at 8:43 PM with a prayer led by Fr. Stan.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### St. Francis School Board:

The grade school is currently advertising for three new positions:

- Food service director open with no applications
- Kindergarten teacher received three applications from the Philippines so far
- Grade school counselor two applicants with interviews pending

A generous donor added a pipe/vent system to fix the smell coming from the grade school restrooms.

Fr. Stan reported that the Archdiocese came and assessed the state of the school grounds.

Family handbook changes were completed for the 2025/2026 school year.

Faculty/staff handbooks are in the process of being updated.

Next school board meeting scheduled for April 24, 2025, at 7 PM.

#### **Finance Board:**

No updates at the time of the meeting.

#### **Development:**

Nebraska Catholic Day of Giving is coming up on May 7 with the giving window opening up on April 21. We are raising money for our math curriculum updates that are needed. There will be an article about this in the upcoming newsletter. We want to encourage everyone to give through the platform so the school receives a match for the donations.

After Easter, there will be a push to establish communication lines for our parish member groups through Flocknote, a communication tool that was used during our Lenten perpetual adoration.

Invitations for the alumni banquet are in the process of being sent out.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

There is work being done on targeting potential installation dates for the church carpet. The initial dates in discussion are the weeks of either May 12 or May 23. Once the dates are finalized, volunteers will be needed to assist with the removal of pews, etc.

Spencer Eisenmenger walked the roofs with the insurance adjuster, and, at this time, there will be no possibility of issuing a claim on any of the campus roofs. Erik Baumgart will reach out to the roofer as there is an immediate need to move forward with the severely damages area of the rectory roof

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Several items were brought up for discussion on items needing repair around the church and school:

- Paint is peeling on the exterior church windows. Steve Wieser and Alan Anderson are working together on the potential option to cover the window panes with tin.
- Vents on the church need to be painted this project may coincide with the exterior windows.
- Fr. Wayne's garden is going to be cleaned up during the upcoming service day. Stan Wemhoff and George Keller are planning to assist.
- There is a drainage issue that has been brought up previously, but the council is unsure as to where the discussion currently stands. Kari Wieseler will follow up with Bryan Reichmuth to see if this issue was discussed upon the archdiocesan inspection.

Discussion was held on the status of the new building committee for the grade school. Spencer Eisenmenger reached out to Tim Werner to get an update. There is a meeting scheduled for April 22 where there are plans to interview architects and contractors.

#### **PASTOR'S REPORT:**

Masses for Holy Week have been set.

First Holy Communion for St. Francis will be held on May 4, 2025, at 1 PM.

Personnel responsible for setting up the youth camp in West Point are planning to come to talk to members of the parish at the end of June.

There has not been mention of Totus Tuus for this summer. Fr. Stan will follow up on this to see if any plans are being made.

No kindergarten teachers have applied yet.

The cleaning contract for the school is being reviewed.

The Installation Mass for Most Reverend Michael G. McGovern will be May 7, 2025, at 2 PM. Tickets are required in order to attend this event.

The next meeting is scheduled for May 15, 2025, at 7 PM.


